The Chesapeake Bay Foundation (CBF) is a nonprofit organization with the mission of protecting the Chesapeake Bay. This article explains that development (building roads, houses, and businesses) has been the leading cause of deforestation and forest habitat loss in the Bay watershed. 750,000 acres of forest land were developed between 1982 and 1997. The CBF has programs to restore forest habitat by planting trees. This article uses an environmental lens. It answers the question - what caused the loss of forest habitat in the Delmarva peninsula (where the Fox squirrel lives.) I will use this article to show how development led to the endangerment of the Delmarva Fox Squirrel. I will need to find more information about programs that restored or protected forest habitat.
